New Perennials, Shrubs & Trees for 2023:

Perennials:

Phlox Paniculata 'Laura': Oldie but goodie. Reliable rebloomer and mildew resistant. Fragrant, wonderful for butterflies and hummingbirds. Fuchsia purple with white center and dark eye.

Hosta Party Streamers: Long, narrow, wiggly yellow leaves form a mounding habit. Its rapid growth rate means you won't have to wait long to see it come to maturity. Deep purple flowers contrast beautifully with the foliage when they bloom in mid to late summer. It's great in combination with shade loving hydrangeas.

Butterfly Bush Flutterby Petite® Tutti

Fruitti Pink: Stunning dwarf shrub has a dense, compact form with upright growth and continues to bloom pink from summer until frost. Butterflies love this flower all summer long! Clip spent flowers to promote continued blooms.

Yarrow (Achillea) Summer Pastels: Pale soft colors of all ranges; from red, pink, yellow, orange, salmon & lilac. Deer resistant and a must have for butterfly gardens.

Daylilies for 2023:

Shrubs:

Hydrangea Little Lime Punch®: Flowers change progressively from the bottom up in a gorgeous array of white, light pink, and rich Hawaiian Punch red! Compact with strong stems. Full to part sun; 36-60" both in height and width.

Hydrangea Wedding Gown: Each fully double, white flower head is like a mini bridal bouquet, with an outer ring of large, double flowers surrounding a center packed with smaller, double ones. Flowering begins earlier than other varieties, and continues on new growth into fall. For shade; 3-4' both height and width.

Diervilla Firefly™: Offers showy clusters of yellow trumpet-shaped flowers at the ends of the branches from late spring to early summer. It has attractive red-variegated deep purple foliage with hints of coppery-bronze which emerges burgundy in spring. The pointy leaves are highly ornamental and turn an outstanding scarlet in the fall. Full sun - shade; 3' x 3'

Ninebark Lady in Red®: A beautiful upright shrub with emerging scarlet foliage that matures to deep red; features small pink flowers followed by subtle reddish fruit, and interesting peeling papery bark. Full Sun to Part Sun; 5' x 5'.

Trees:

Tulip: A fast-growing shade tree with bright green leaves that turn golden yellow in fall. Greenish-yellow flowers are carried high in the tree when it is around 10 years old. Stems are aromatic. Likes full sun. Grows to 70' x 40'.

Dakota Pinnacle Birch: As an introduction from North Dakota, it is very hardy. It's great for smaller landscapes its habit is columnar. Stunning golden fall color. 40' x 12'

Perfect Purple™ Flowering Crab: As a newer introduction this crab is highly resistant to common crab tree diseases. Deep pink blooms set the spring stage for dark purple foliage that form on upright branching. Very cold hardy. Fall color is bright red with small red berries that persist through winter for wildlife. Height: 20' Spread: 15' Shape: Upright

Prairie Statesman Swiss Stone Pine: A great specimen tree with a narrow pyramidal shape. A near perfect compact, very hardy evergreen for spatially challenged landscapes. This tree is very drought tolerant so plant in a drier area of your landscape. Needles are soft, dark green in color with a bluish hue to them. Grows to 25' x 10'

Plant Talk:

There are a group of plants, *Hydrangea paniculatas*, that have just exploded in popularity. They are the sun loving hydrangea that reach only 2 to 3 feet in size. They are the perfect plant for our area. *Hydrangea paniculatas* have great branching, broad tough leaves with high disease resistance and beautiful summer blooms. An amazing landscape plant for the tough climate Nebraska throws at them. Plant them in combination with the easy care and drought tolerant ornamental grasses. Adding this duo to your favorite evergreen gives you a foolproof four-season landscape! Check these out at Harmony Nursery Garden Center this Spring:

Flare™ Hydrangea will light a flame in your landscape with its fiery red blooms. In early summer, creamy white panicle blooms emerge from rich green foliage and begin to transform into richer and richer shades of pink and red as summer fades to fall. Flare grows in a tidy upright mound to the height of 3 feet.

Fire Light Tidbit® is a dwarf hydrangea for the front of the border with a bun-shaped habit and proportionately sized, rounded blooms. The late-season blooms emerge a creamy, light green-white and quickly begin to turn raspberry pink, creating a pleasing blend of colors not seen before.

Little Hottie™ has a very full flower head with florets that emerge green and turn sparkling white. This well-branched, compact hydrangea is covered in large bloom from the bottom to the top. Will withstand the extreme heat and wind.

Little Lime Punch® will put on an awe-inspiring show during the summer. The flowers turn white, pink and eventually settle into a rich red. While the transition takes place, the flower bunches display a stunning ombre fade. As this hydrangea reblooms throughout the summer, the shrub will have flower clusters in various stages of the color transition.
