### New Perennials, Shrubs & Trees for 2025:

#### Perennials:

Hosta Yellow Polka Dot Bikini: Beautiful small apple green hosta with bright yellow margins and white streaks near the center. 9"H x 17"W.

Phlox Pink Lightning: Flowers are large, bright true pink in color with a white starburst center.

#### Igloo Mums: Warm, Brillant, & Cool.

Unlike other garden mums, these are hardy and will return year after year. Great habit of 2' x 2.5'.

#### **Daylilys:**

(PW) Fearfully & Wonderfully Made: Pink coral 5.5" blooms have rich cranberry/red eye with fun pie crust edges.

Rich in Mercy: Deep purple 5.5" flowers have a lavender watermark with a white edge. Very sunfast.

**Hanalei Bay:** We are excited about this beauty! 6" overlapping ruffled pale pink petals with a nice rounded form and feature wide blue-purple banding with matching eye zone.

#### **Shrubs:**

Grin and Tonic® Reblooming Hydrangea: Stunning lime green blooms that age to white. Great for a part sun area. 2'x 2.5' tall and wide.

**Pinky Winky Prime® Hydrangea:** Looking for a large, beautiful shrub for a specimen or a border. Look no farther. This hydrangea has larger blooms and is 6' to 9' tall and wide.

Tuff Stuff Top Fun® Hydrangea: Showy large magenta pink to purple shades of lace cap flowers. 2' x 3' tall and wide.

Bonanza Patio Peach Tree: Great for a small specimen tree in the landscape. It has full double pink blooms in the spring and deep red leaves that stay on all summer. It produces medium to large sweet juicy peaches! 6' tall.

**FlowerFull® Hydrangea:** A new arborescens type. Much stronger stems and good disease resistance. Holds the profusion of flowers upright on the plant. 3'H x 4'W.

Jade Parade® Sand Cherry: Low maintenance shrub with arching branches that boast glossy blueish-green leaves that turn shades of yellow, orange, and red in the fall. In the spring it is covered with white blooms that are followed by small black cherries. 2'H x 4'W.

#### **Trees:**

Canadian Hemlock: We love these evergreen trees. They have been on our property for over 25 years. Slow to Medium growth with a height of 40'H x 25'W. Graceful with soft branches.

Juniper Blue Point: Reaches 12'H x 8'W. A blue-green foliage evergreen. A favorite for tall screens and stately lawn specimens.

**Woodward Juniper:** 20'H x 3'W. Very Hardy upright juniper offers the appearance of Italian Cypress in colder climates. The blue-green foliage turns grey-blue in winter adding interest.

**Silveray Korean Pine:** Super hardy and a beautiful specimen tree for small landscape. We have one in our East driveway gardens. Upright slender form with green and silver needles that twist and turn giving it an overall silver appearance.

### Jenni's Thoughts:

When you come and visit Harmony Nursery during the growing season; (April – November) and have the time to wander through the gardens there are some notable plants to locate and fall in love with!

Garden 11 is the home of Apollo® Sugar Maple, Princess Diana Serviceberry, Amsonia hubrichii.

Garden 12 shows off a Bonfire Patio Peach, our collection of sun-loving hydrangeas, Kindred Spirit® Oak Tree, yellow twig dogwood (winter gorgeous), and our collection of hardy hibiscus (August bloom). A very large Techno® Arborvitae stands strong watching over the garden in all seasons!

East & West Driveways are the home to a Silveray Korean Pine which is small in stature, yet such a great specimen pine tree. You will also find one of my favorite trees there, a Sunburst® Honeylocust.

Across the drive I have a **White Pine** that has been tested and survived some rough storms. It reminds me of a Dr. Suess tree, but it is still standing, and I planted it 30 years ago! It is the elder of my forest. Not perfect, but I have learned a lot from its strength! We also have a **Buttonbush Sugar Shack**® shrub planted in the East Driveway. A great native shrub that will handle a soggy area and attract the Swallowtail butterfly and other pollinators.

Garden 8, we have the stately Taylor Junipers that have grown straight and tall, heading to 30'. The Heptacodium tree: Seven-sons flower, is impressive August through September with white blooms that host all the pollinators in the gardens. The blooms are followed by rose-pink calyces that are showy into late fall. The native Asclepias tubersa has also established itself in the garden. It is the host for the Monarch Butterfly to lay its eggs and also the caterpillar's first meal! Sporobolus wrigthii grass (Great Sacaton), stands strong in the summer winds. You will also find our famous hydrangea Quick Fire® that puts on a show of beautiful white bloom bouquets!

I hope you can find some time to just come visit and enjoy our four-season gardens!
